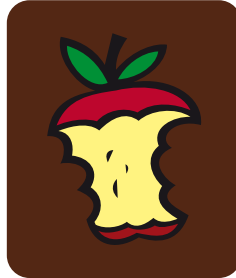

We have tried to bring together all the most common waste we usually produce at home, listed them in alphabetical order and near each entry we have put the sack and the right way to dispose.

Good practices

Find out how to collect separate waste

- Carefully separate packaging depending on their material and put into the proper sack for separate waste collection
- Reduce the volume of packaging
- When possible, part packaging made of different materials and remove food leftovers
- Properly distinguish and dispose aluminium and steel packaging
- Dispose into the light Multi-material BLUE sack every kind of plastic packaging
- Be aware that paper dirty with food has to be disposed into bio-degradable and compost sack; paper dirty with soil, with poisoning substances like solvents or paints, till receipts have to be disposed into the YELLOW sack of Urban Solid Waste
- Reduce the quantity of waste. Select products: with less packaging, concentrated, family format, rechargeable
- Select recycled or reusable product
- When possible, reuse items, starting from packaging which can be recycled
- Take your bag. Going to shopping, bring your reusable bag with you
- Only if necessary, use throwaway products. Outwardly functional, they turn into big amount of waste
- If possible, choose and buy on tap or loose products, avoiding useless packaging
- Avoid food waste. Buy zero miles food, seasonal products and in the right quantity. Prepare and cook the right food portion and enjoy reusing leftovers to create new tasting dishes
- Before throwing away every kind of items, consider if it can be useful to other people or if it can be gifted or repaired/recovered

This glossary aims to support you to well separate, to better recycle, to respect disposal rules and to produce less waste

Practical guide for door-to-door separate waste collection

What you should put into...



MULTIMATERIAL BLUE SACK

PLASTIC: bottles, flacons and dispensers, hard boxes packaging; bags, disposable dishes and glasses. **Do not dispose:** throwaway cutlery, toys, CD or DVD boxes, household tools.
METALLIC CANS and TINS



PAPER SACK

PAPER AND CARDBOARD: clean paper, cardboard and boards in general after having reduced sizes and volumes, newspapers and magazines, drink containers.

BE CAREFUL that to dispose bigger quantity or volume of paper and cardboard, you can use non-returnable paper bags or cardboard boxes!

Remember: you have to reduce their volume and tie them together.



YELLOW SACK - SOLID URBAN WASTE (S.U.W.)

Everything it is NOT possible to separate or recover.

I.e. Throwaway cutlery, toys, CD or DVD boxes, household tools, pens, used lighters, cigarette butts, sweepings, worn garments and fabrics, china and porcelain items, dirty food boxes or chemical substances....

How to manage the other kinds of waste?

ORGANIC FRACTION into BIO-DEGRADABLE and COMPOSTABLE sack

To be disposed in brown kerbside bins depending on own needs.

What should I put into bio-degradable and compostable sack of organic fraction?

Decayed food, crumbs, fruit and vegetable peels, coffee or grounds, cakes, fade flowers, leaves, egg shells, molluscs or dried fruit, fish bones, fruit pits, animal bones with skin and plumage, remains of pasta and bread, rice, seeds, tea, fruit cores, vegetable waste, tea bags, cooking blotting paper, corks, used paper napkins, cardboard bowls (used for cakes), paper or natural materials which can be easily transformed into compost, including vegetation and small pruning, animal litter.

Attention: YOU CAN ALSO USE BIO-DEGRADABLE AND COMPOSTABLE shopping bags



GLASS

JARS, GLASSES, BOTTLES (without metal cap)
GREEN KERBSIDE BINS DEPENDING ON YOUR NEEDS



DISPOSABLE NAPPIES AND ADULT DIAPERS - ALL MEDICAL DEVICES WITH NEEDLE (syringes with secured needle)

TO BE DISPOSED ONLY AND EXCLUSIVELY INTO THE YELLOW KERBSIDE BIN

It is forbidden to dispose every other kind of waste

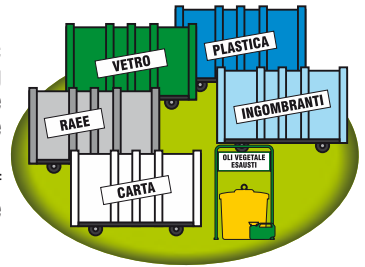


You can request and collect for free sacks and information leaflets at the Environment Office of your Municipality or request sacks at shops that show waste collection transfers.

BULKY ITEMS AND WEEE* (electric and electronic equipment)

Bulky items (armchairs, sofas, mattresses etc...), electric and electronic equipment (including bulbs) have to be disposed at the proper Recycling centre. To know opening hours and information, you can call our toll free number 800.640.323 of Cosmari or your Municipal offices or check the Eco-Calendar or the website www.raccoltaportaaporta.it

Use your local Recycling centre every time you need. Please, check if in your town it is available the door-to-door pick up of bulky items or if the Reuse centre has been activated.



Pruning and mowing waste?

Vegetation, branches, pruning and mowing waste can be disposed in limited quantity in transparent or black sacks labelled "Grass" or in bundle. This kind of waste has to be placed near the Organic bins respecting Eco-Calendar rules. Otherwise you can contact the toll free number **800.640.323** to know the right disposal days.

How can I make domestic compost?

People owning a yard or living in rural areas can apply for a compost bin, addressing their request to their local Environment or Technical Offices. Compost bin allows to easily transform food leftovers into compost to be used as soil improver for garden and pots.



For non-domestic users?

Besides the common services reserved to domestic users, other utilities are available:

Commercial, artisanal and industrial business

PACKAGING: collected in specific days and hours

Big users and retail and catering business:

GLASS: collected in specific days and hours

ORGANIC FRACTION: brown bins depending on needs

For all non-domestic users: YELLOW SACK - Solid Urban Waste - collected in specific days and hours
